It is a scramble format with a requirement of two drives from each player in the group. There will be contests on the course. Complimentary beverages will be available throughout the round followed by a BBQ lunch, raffle, and awards presentations in the clubhouse following play. Player packages are priced at \$250 for individual golfers and \$1000 for teams of four. Participants may sign up to golf individually, as a team or through a sponsorship package. Shotgun start at 8 am following a 7:15 am putting contest.
